- Management of Industrial Waste

Scrap copper winding wire, scrap motors and paper are recycled. Oily water purification tanks are regularly cleaned and serviced.

- Substantial Noise Control Measures

We have implemented noise control measures to rectify all situations where noise levels exceed 90 dB(A). Furthermore, sound proofing materials are installed around any equipment that creates 85 dB(A) of noise or more in order to prevent noise pollution.

- Exhaust Management Systems

We spare no effort when it comes to air quality management. In striving for perfection, we continually improve our control equipment, find new ways of reducing emissions and perform regular inspections and maintenance on our equipment.

- Minimize Environmental Impact

We are mindful of our daily impact on the environment. As a result, we minimize electricity and water consumption and recycle and reuse materials wherever possible.
